

Can Your Child Care Provider Get Paid?

Effective February 1, 2008, your non-licensed child care provider **WILL NOT** be paid until a Fingerprint Background Clearance has been received by the child care payment agency.

- If your child care provider does not pass the background check and is denied, he or she <u>WILL NOT BE PAID FOR ANY</u> <u>CHILD CARE SERVICES</u>.
 - Any Felony or Misdemeanor will generate a DENIAL.
- Your child care provider's check will not be issued until a background clearance has been received.
- Providers who receive a background clearance will only be paid up to 120 days of prior care.

This does not apply to non-licensed relatives (aunt/uncle or grandparents)
